Software demonstration (on-/off-site): 30 mins

Short paper/Work-in-progress report (on-/off-site): 10 mins

Research blurb (on-site as posters/off-site as prerecorded video presentations): 3-5 mins

Abstracts must be **anonymized** and **not exceed 500 words** (including references). They should clearly state **research question(s)**, **approach**, **data**, **method**, and (expected) **results**. Authors are allowed to submit two abstracts if at least one of the papers is co-authored.
